


With reference to the application on the subject  
cited above, I am directed to grant recognition to your

session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms  
and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of  
Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973 framed  
thereunder as well as the instructions issued from  
time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any  
discrimination of caste and creed and preference  
shall be given to the students of Gautampuri &  
Brahampuri area.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified  
and eligible staff for the classes of the school  
as per the present norms of the Department.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Lab. as per  
the norms of the Department and suitable facilities  
for practical work shall be provided to the  
students.
5. That a proper library shall be established and  
facilities for reading-room shall also be made  
available for students as well as for teachers.  
Books as per the ratio of 10 Books per student  
may be added and facilities of reading-room may  
also be provided immediately. Books worth Rs.2000/-  
may also be purchased immediately.
6. That adequate sports materials shall be purchased  
and made available to the students immediately.

7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Sec.10(i) of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 Sq.ft. per students for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Dto. of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of the existing sections should not exceed the number of class-rooms of proper size in the school.
9. That the school shall not run any pre-primary and unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the school, if any. No branch of this school shall be run under the banner of the recognised school.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That service contract between the management and the staff shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provisions of Rules 6, 7 & 9 be strictly observed.
13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.
14. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) in a joint account in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.
15. That the violation of any instruction/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school. That class IX shall not be added to the school without the prior permission of the Director of Education, Delhi.
16. That the school society shall apply for the allotment of land and will construct the building as per specifications.

9. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.

Fresh Health certificates from MCD be obtained and produced to Education Officer for verification.

The Management of the school will obtain land from DDA if already not obtained, in the name of the Society through Director of Education, Delhi and shall construct the school building thereon for the school Act as per specifications of the Deptt. within a period of two years. That adequate and sufficient accommodation of 10 sqft. per student shall be provided for the class room. The normal size of the class room will 15' x 20'.

That proper facilities for drinking water, toilets and first aid be provided. Separate toilets for boys, girls and separate toilets for ladies and gents staff be also provided.

That the Managing Committee of the school shall not increase/enhance fee during the ensuing academic session without prior approval of the Director of Education which is mandatory requirement under sub-section (3) of Section 17 of Delhi School Education Act & Rules 1973.

That all the facilities prescribed under rules 50 & 51 of the Delhi School Education Rules 1973 shall be made available to the students.

That XI th class should not be added without the prior approval of the Directorate of Education.

That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund equal to minimum three months salary of the staff in the joint name of the Directorate of Education and the Manager of the school.

That the school shall comply with the norms of the CBSE for affiliation fee/examination purposes.

That report about the fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the Education officer within six months.

The management of each class will be per person and undertaking.
